Since 2008, MIT *Technology Review* has partnered with Opinno to bring the magazine and the Innovators Under 35 Awards to Latin America and Europe.






Innovators under 35 Europe



The Process

A group of Influencers in Europe, experts on Innovation, entrepreneurship and technology help us discover the most inspiring young people. The top institutions, companies, networks and media outlets in each country partner with us and help us spread the word.

Once nominations are closed, each candidate is evaluated by at least 3 expert judges from more than 200 judges, selected among academia, investors, and experts in all areas of technology. The editors of the magazine review the evaluations while adding their own criteria and then decide the final list of 10 winners.

The winners of each country will be represented on an Event Roadshow: Paris, Brussels, Italy, Berlin, Spain, Poland... Where each winner will Pitch their project, other Innovators will share their experience, and challenge the audience to get ideas flowing.
