

Jeremy Wallace (BA Honours, University of Victoria, 1992; MA, University of Victoria, 1993; Diplôme en littérature française, École Normale Supérieure Fontenay/St-Cloud, Paris, 1996; PhD [French], University of British Columbia, 1999), joined the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade in 2001.
